She not setting forth in the said adv^{ce} that adv^{ce} was to her granted nor by whom. — Lastly the said declaration is defective in matter of Substance & wants forme &c. —

Whereupon the Said Abraham Gurnham by his attorney aforesaid prays that the Said Elizth Court
admit & may answer to his plea of Demurrer aforesaid But the Said Elizabeth Court altho' solemnly
called comes not nor to the plea of Demurrer of the aforesaid Abraham further answereth nor is he doct^r
in the plea aforesaid prosecuted against the Said Abraham
