In Case the said John Huggins do not make his personal appearance before the Justices of our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June next to answer unto his Lordship concerning all such matters and things as shall be then & there objected against him on his said Lordships behalf & to stand & abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon & not to depart the same Court without License thereof &c.

In Case he does not make his personal appearance before the Justices of our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County the third Tuesday of June next to answer unto his said Lordship his heirs & Successors concerning all such matters & things as shall be then & there objected against him on his said Lordships behalf & to stand & abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon and not to depart the same Court without License thereof &c.
