: her One of his Lordships Justices of the peace for Somerset County to keep &
and did acknowledge herself to owe and be indebted to his Lordship the Sum of five pounds
Court money due to be levied on her goods and chattels, Lands and tenements for the use of his
Said Lordship - The condition of which Recognizance is Such that if Hannah Ford do
doe make her person all appearance before the Justice, of our Said County Court to be hold at
Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March next to give Evidence ag^t Richard Driskill of the
Said County on Behalf of his Said Lordship then this Recognizance to be void Else to remain in
full force & virtue in Law

Whereupon the said Hannah Ford altho' solemnly called comes not but makes
default &c. Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the afo^r Recognizance of
five pounds Court money so afo^r entered into by the said Hannah Ford, be forfeited & that
the same become due to the said Lord proprietary afo^r and to his use & to be levied &c.

Whereupon it is Rendered to this Court that there is two Bridges Over the Branches at
the head of Winkawomoc River in Somerset County very much Enjoined and are dangerous
for travellers, the One called Long bridge & the Other the Cypress Bridge &c. and whereas
a certain Lewis Disharoon & Henry Taddonie both of Somerset County present here in
Court, the Justices do agree with them the said Henry Taddonie & Lewis Disharoon to build
Erect and Compleat one ~~amendable~~ good & Substantial Bridge Over Each Branch
the said Bridges to be Nine foot wide, the frames to be made of good Cypress, & to be Laid
with good Cypress Plank two Inch thick to be well brimmed down, the said Bridges
to be arch'd Every ten foot and to be well Braced with good Brakes &c.

The said Bridges to be finish'd and done by the Last day of October next Ensuing
In consideration of which work (if well done) the said Lewis Disharoon and Henry Taddonie
is to have the Sum of five thousand pounds of tobacco to be paid at the Laying of
the County Levy next

and hogs and Other Substance he was possessed withall that then he the said Somerset Dickenson
would find and provide for him all Such Necessaries as would be sufficient for him to have and
wear during his transitory Life &c. - Whereupon the said Cornelius Morris delivered the
same up unto the said Somerset Dickenson But since that the said Somerset refuses &
delays to comply with the agreement afo^r Between them made &c.
