And the said Stinger Dickson and Joyce his wife by Leon Galatin attorney come and defend the one and injury when &c and pray Leave to Imparte hereunto until the next Court and they have it and the same day is given to the plff also --- Att which said next Court to witt the Nineteenth day of November and doth One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three Come again the said party by their attorney aft and the said doct by their said attorney pray further Leave to Imparte hereunto until the next Court and they have it and the same day is given to the plff also --- Att which said next Court to witt the Seventeenth day of March and doth One thousand Seven hundred and

twenty three Come again the said party by their attorney aft and the said doct by attorney of the same doct say that he is not Inframed by his ^{the same doct} Cyants of any answer by the same doct to the aft doct in the plea aft to be risen and Nothing Else there of says whereby the same plff remain against the aft doct those of undoubted --- But because it is unknown unto the Justice here what damages the said Anne Selby hath sustained by Omission of the premises aft Thereupon the Justice here at the prayer of the plff attorney aft and by consent of the aft doct according to act of assembly do assent the damages of the said plff by Omission of the premises aft beyond his Costs and Charges in this behalf said Out & Expended to four pound fifteen Shillings Curr. money &c.

Therefore it is Considered by the Justice here the same day and Year last mentioned that the said Anne Selby Recover against the said Stinger Dickson & Joyce his wife as well the sum of four pound fifteen Shillings Curr. money her damages aft in fact aft, by the Justice aforesaid as also the sum of Seventeen hundred & seven pound of Tobacco by the Court here adjudged unto her for her Costs and Charges by her about her Suite in this behalf said Out and Expended & the doct in money &c

And wherupon the said John Larimore by Leon Gale his attorney Complaines that whereas the aft John Collins the tenth day of May One thousand Seven hundred and twenty One and Long before and always since at the parish aft within the Jurisdiction of this Court was and is a person that commonly useth to goe by water Shippor or master of a Shallop or Vessel and to take upon himselfe the Charge and Care of the said Shallop or Vessel or Loading and such things as belongs to the said Vessel or be put on board her for a reasonable Lawfull hire or Sallery according to the Usual agreement and paymt. in that behalf to be made and had and also that whereas according to Law and Custom of great Brittain and this province of Maryland all such Shippors or Masters of Shallops or Vessels who doe Receive goods and Chattels of ~~any~~ any manner of persons to be carried and delivered in such Lawfull manner and place as by them shall be agreed upon for a reasonable and Lawfull Sallery or hire to them therefore to be given and paid are Bound to Keep and Carry and deliver the goods and Chattels of such persons so as aft Received in such manner and to such place as is agreed upon or aft safe and without Loosing Spoiling or withholding them or any part of them so that by default of such Shippor or master of such Shallop or Vessel, the damage should happen to such persons by carrying their Carriages and whereas the aft John Collins the tenth day of May One thousand Seven hundred & twenty One at a parish aft within the Jurisdiction aft had taken upon him ^{self} the Charge of being Shippor or master of a (Shallop)
