John Burnall of Somerset County Gent: and one of the Justices of the said County, Brings into Court a certain Nathaniel Hopkins and offers him to the Court as his deputy is approved of the taking the several Oaths appointed by Law. Whereupon the said Nath Hopkins took the several Oaths appointed by Law & Subscribed the Oath of Allegiance and test &c

Whereas there was certain articles or conditions made up and concluded upon by and Between a certain Cornelius Morris and a certain Somerset Dickenson, but the said Somerset Dickenson not complying with the same agreement or condition &c. Therefore it is ordered by the Court that the said Somerset Dickenson give good security for the performance of the same agreement or conditions on his part to be performed and likewise to find and provide for the said Cornelius Morris and his wife all such necessities as might be sufficient for amending and during their Natural Lives and Not suffer them to be abused &c

Whereupon the said Somerset Dickenson together with Samuel Riggall and William Cuyper his Security all present here in Court acknowledged themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto the said Cornelius Morris in the sum of fifty pounds Stere money each to be levied on the Body good, and Chattle, Land, or tenements for the use of the said Cornelius Morris Justly & lawfully to be levied &c In Case the said Somerset Dickenson do not comply with the agreement or conditions aforesaid on his part to be performed and that the said Cornelius Morris go home with the said Somerset Dickenson &c

John Scarbrough appointed Overseer of the road in Mathegan Hundred from Bequaetown to town lead to John Cooper Bridge &c

Upon the motion of a certain Richard Phillips writ to obtain the Orphans of Robert French to have their Estate the same being lately bequeathed by a certain Nathaniel French who Intermarried with the mother of the said Orphans &c. Whereupon it is ordered by the Court that the said Richard Phillips take the Estate of the said Orphans in to his custody and care until such time as the said Nathaniel French who Intermarried with the Mother of the said Orphans as aforesaid, shall appear and give good security for the preservation of the said Estate for the use of the Orphans &c

Francis Allen of Somerset County Gent: is appointed Overseer of the road in Corsmoor hundred in the stead of Edmund Dickenson that is to say to Carle road from Dindung Creek Bridge to the River within two Miles of Southey & Wittington - and that he have the Liberty to appoint a deputy &c
