His Lordship } Somerset: The Jurors for the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of
Mary Bolitha } this province that Now is for the Body of Somerset County upon their Oaths do
present that Mary Bolitha late of Brentley parish in the County of Gloucester
in the Year One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three at the parish aforesaid in the County
aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court unlawfully committed two Felony persons against
the peace &c. and also against the form of the act of assembly in such premises and provided &c.

On the Back of the foregoing Bill of Indictment ^{L. Gale Esq.} it was then ordered by J. Bullen Esq. Adam
Article foreman Thereupon Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset
County that he should take the said Mary Bolitha if she should be found in his Bailiwick
and there should safe keep so that he might have her body before the Justices of his Lordships
County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June next to
answer unto his Lordship concerning aforesaid Indictment against her found &c. and that thereof
he should not fail &c. At which said third Tuesday of June to wit the sixteenth day

of the same month and Year One thousand Seven hundred & twenty four Being the day of the
return of the said writ from the Sher. of Somerset County and under return thereof to the Just.

Legi. Corpus of J. M. Foster Sher. Whereupon the said Mary Bolitha by Francis Allen her attorney appears. and thereupon the
said J. M. Foster her attorney, who for his said Lordship in this behalf presents
cometh into Court and saith that he will not any further prosecute the said Mary Bolitha
on the Indictment aforesaid nor further therewith in anywise Intermitt &c.

Wherefore it is considered by the Justices here that his said Lordship take Nothing by the
Indictment aforesaid but ^{that the said Mary} be her of acquittal &c.

His Lordship } We of the Jury do present Richard Driskie for the foregoing aforesaid
Richard Driskie } (Ind. on the Body of Mannaf. Ind. W. Fergus foreman)

Thereupon Command is given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take the said Richard
Driskie if he be to answer for and afterwards in the same Court from the said Richard Driskie
(in Custody of the Sher. and being set to the Bar is thereupon Instantly demanded how he would
acquitt him self of the premises aforesaid upon him Imposed days he is guilty thereof ^{in meaning to} and pay
thirty Shillings for his fine for aforesaid. Therefore it is considered by the Justices
here that the said Richard Driskie be fined for his said Lordship the Sum of thirty Shillings for
the fact aforesaid, thereupon the said Richard Driskie is discharged having security for payment
of the several Officers the fees due upon the presentment aforesaid. Whereupon aforesaid Master
Driskie present in Court acknowledged him self in ten pounds that he should &c. In case he
doth not pay the several Officers their fees due as aforesaid
