Whereupon the said John Dennis by his attorney of and prays that the said Rachel Cowse being of the same Samuel Cowse to his writ of Summons of may answer but if said Rachel altho' solemnly called Cometh not nor shows Cause why &c but makes default whereby the said John Dennis against the said doth stand as if defended &c

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the sixteenth day of June and that one thousand seven hundred and twenty four and that the said John Dennis have his Execution against the said Rachel Cowse of the same Samuel Cowse for the sum of four hundred & thirty five pounds of too his debt of as also the sum of two hundred & seven pounds of too Costs of Suite in the Judgm^t of & specified as also the sum of Two hundred and sixty pounds of by the Court here Judged unto him for his Costs and Damages Sustained by reason of delay of Execution of the Judgm^t of to be levied of the goods and Chattels which were of the said Samuel Cowse at the time of his death remaining in the hands of the said Rachel Cowse and to be administered if so much thereof in her hands she hath &c and if so much thereof in her hands she hath not &c then the Costs last mentioned to be levied of the proper goods and Chattels of the said Rachel Cowse &c
