The said Charles by Francis Allen his attorney Complaines that whereas the said Thomas the thirteenth day of November last did owe and owe him and seven hundred & seven teen at the County of Dorset to wit at the parish and County of Somerset at within the said Division of this Court was indebted unto the said Charles in Eight hundred & seven pounds of tobacco for his in them. For and publick dues and for barance thereupon to the said Charles then & there due owing and unpaid as by account thereof made and annexed may in Court appear and being so the said Charles in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid at the place aforesaid in consideration thereof upon him self affirmed and to the said Charles then and there forth fully did promise that he the said Thomas the said Eight hundred & seven pounds of tobacco to the said Charles when he should be afterwards thereunto requested he would well and faithfully pay and Content Now the said Charles Thomas his promise and assumption of himself made a little regarding but plotting and fraudulently Intending the said Charles in that part of his duty and Subtly to deceive and defraud the said Eight hundred & seven pounds of tobacco to the said Charles he hath not paid or to him for the same in anywise Contented altho the same to be the said Thomas by the said Charles on the first day of March in the year aforesaid often aforesaid at the parish & County aforesaid within the said Division of lawes thereunto requested but the same to him to pay or in any wise to Content hath refused thereunto before and deny whereupon the said Charles hath that he is wrong and hath damage to the value of Sixteen hundred & twenty two pounds of tobacco & thereupon he being Sule for.
