In case the said John Evans shall not leave him to read and find him sufficient accommodations with washing washing and lodging during the said Journey his Convalescence

John Ricketts - Whereas a certain Mary Roberts servant to one John Ricketts being presented for absenting herself from the said John Ricketts the said Mary Roberts appears and submits to the Court and confesses the fact and forasmuch as the Court could not proceed to Judgment against the said Mary Roberts on the presentment aforesaid before the Court. It is ordered by the Court that the said Mary Roberts give Security with thirty pounds Court money for her appearance before the Justices of our County Court to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June next and to stand and abide the Judgment of the Court and not to depart the same Court without License thereof.

Whereupon the said John Ricketts master of the said Mary Roberts presented here in Court undertakes for the said Mary Roberts and acknowledged himself to be and stand justly indebted unto his Lordship the Right honorable the Lord Croquiere in the sum of thirty pounds Court money to be levied on his body goods or Chattels Lands or Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors. In case the said Mary Roberts do not make her personal appearance before the Justices of our County Court to be hold at Dividing Creek in Somers County the third Tuesday of June next and to stand and abide the Judgment of the Court and not to depart the same Court without License thereof. Then aforesaid Croquiere to be void otherwise to stand and remain in full force and virtue in Law.

Edward Gould - To the worshipful his Lordships Justices of the Peace for Somers County the humble Petition of Edward Gould Esquire that Whereas your Petitioner is aged near seventy and in great measure hath lost his Eye sight and being considerably hindered unfit for Labour therefore humbly prays your Worships to release and exempt him from paying taxes and your Petitioner is in duty bound shall ever pray &c. The Premises aforesaid being considered. It is therefore ordered by the Court that the said Edward Gould be for the future free as by the Petition aforesaid is said.
