The said John Elroy Esq^r Esquire heretofore in Court doth promise by these presents to leave the said John and Ernoel Elroy Jun^r to read write and cypher as far as the law of three and to take the estate of the said John and Ernoel Elroy into his hands ^{and possession} when known what it is and to return the same againe to the said John and Ernoel Elroy when they shall arrive to full years to receive the same and to find them sufficient meat drink washing Lodging and Coaling during their servitude &c - Whereupon it is ordered by the Court that the said John Elroy Jun^r give Security with two Sureties in the sum of fifty pounds Court money for the performance of the above &c - Whereupon the said John Elroy Jun^r together with George Dashed and Capwate King his Sureties or all present in Court acknowledged themselves to be and stand Justly Indebted unto the Joyntly and Severally unto the said John Elroy Jun^r and Ernoel Elroy Jun^r in the sum of fifty pounds Court money to be levied on their bodies goods or Chattels Land outwards to the use of the said John and Ernoel Elroy Jun^r. Between Capt Nathaniel Anson and of Somers County and C^t: William Cuttbridge of Bermuda) to the said Capt Nath^l: Anson &c The Court having heard their severall allegations ruled that the attachment should Issue against the said Edward North on demand &c

Ordered by the Court that Henry Plowde be removed from Alexander Stalls Gent^l and Lodged in the Court house at Duding Creek in the Room or Chamber over the Seat of Judicature &c
