Wherefore the damages, as found being not within the Jurisdiction of this Court to give
Judgment on the Verdict as for the same -

Therefore it is considered by the Justice here the sixteenth day of June and one
thousand seven hundred & twenty four that the said John Caty take nothing by his writ &c. &c.
but be in money for his false Claim and that the said Robert Martin go there without day &c.
and also it is considered by the Justice that the said Robert Martin recover against the said J^r.

(1964) Caty the Sum of Nineteen hundred & sixty four - - - - - pounds &c.
by the Court here adjudged unto him for his Costs and Charges by him about his defence in this behalf
said out &c. &c. according to the form of the Statute in such Case lately made &c. proved
and the said Robert Martin have thereof &c. &c.

It is ruled by the Court that Robert Martin immediately answer unto his said Lord-
ship Concerning an assault and Battery by him the said Robert made on a certain John Caty as
appears by certain Verdict of a Jury that passed between him the said John Caty & the said Robt.
Martin - The said Robert Martin present here in Court. Confesseth himself guilty of the
fact and submits to the mercy of the Court - and is willing to pay his fine for the fact &c. &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Justice here that the said Robert Martin be fined to his
Lordship the Lord Proprietary the Sum of One hundred pounds of Tobacco for the fact &c. &c. thereupon
in the said Robert Martin is discharged paying the fine &c. &c. the several Officers their fees that
arise by Oath of the premises &c. &c.

W. T. Charles Gresham } Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take

Gresham of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. and that thereof he should not fail &c.

At which said third Tuesday of March to wit the Seventeenth day of the same Month and Year -
One thousand seven hundred & twenty three being the day of the return of the said writ Cometh
the said Charles Gresham by W^m Tawson his attorney &c. the Sher. of Somerset County to whom the fore-
going writ was directed Likewise Cometh and Maketh return thereof to the Court the said
