His Lordship } W^ce of His grand Jury do present Joseph Holder for feloniously bearing away two
 ag^t J^r. Holder - Hogg, belonging to Edward Cawdry the sixteenth off^tly in Stogry Parish against
 t^t f^t of an act of Assembly of this Province and against & Co^d - James Rownd for man
 Test^r. John Richard Constable -

The person Commanded was given to the Sher^t of Somersett County
 that he shoule take the Said Joseph Holder if^t to answer &^t And now shew^t to wit the Plaintiff the day
 of March Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three the Said Joseph Holder in Custody
 of the Sher^t aff^t in whose Custody before that day was committed for the same aff^t, and the Said Joseph
 Holder being sent to the Bar in the Court Instantly demanded how he would acquit himself of the felony aff^t
 said he is guilty thereof and thereof by all pretences upon the Country
 and William Tapowdell who for his said Lordship in this Court proceeded in such manner -

The person Commanded is given to the Sher^t of Somersett County that Immedi-
 ately he cause to come before him by whom & who will be to recognize him because as well & of which
 Said Person to the Said Sher^t to wit Joseph Meister Gentle makes return that he has been ready to come
 as by his said Lordship he was commanded and the Justices hereinafter mentioned being called came to
 with William Lane, John Dennis S^r John Hardy, John Scarbrough, John Riard, Richard Tyler
 John Brattan, Samuel Turner, Samuel Alexander, William Lewis, John Atkinson, Henry Ayers who being
 duly called tried and sworn to say the truth without any fear upon their Oath did say that the Said Joseph
 Holder is guilty of the felony as above is Imposed upon him - Whereupon the Court had
 valued the two Leggs in the Court room and mentioned to Sir Phillips - Wherefore it is considered by
 the Justices here that the Said Joseph Holder pay unto the Said Edward Cawdry the party defrauded four fold
 of the value of the two Leggs and amounting in the whole to the sum of Twenty four Shillings - and that the
 Said Joseph Holder be whipt with twenty Lashes on the Bare Back w^t laid on until his Blood appear
 and that he stand in the Pillory a quarter of an hour and that he be taken & and thereupon as to Corporate
 Commitment aff^t Committed is given to the Sher^t of Somersett County that he do thereof immediately Execution
 according to the Judg^t aff^t rendered by whiping the aff^t Joseph Holder at the Publick whipping post with twenty
 Lashes on the Bare Back w^t laid on until his Blood appear and by setting him in the Pillory a quar-
 ter of an hour and afterwards in the same Court the Sher^t return that he has done the Execution of the
 Judg^t aff^t as to Corporate Commitment as he was Commanded - But for that the Justices here as yet are
 not advised in the Compleating their Judg^t aff^t and upon the Premise aff^t day is therefore given the Said
 Joseph Holder in Custody of the Sher^t to bear him of their Judg^t until the ^{last} ^{six} ^{day} of April
 next for that the Justices as yet are not & At which ^{six} ^{day} of April Anno Domini One thousand
 Seven hundred and twenty three, being the sixteenth day of the same month comes the Said Joseph Holder
 in Custody as aff^t, and forasmuch as the Said Joseph Holder hath not sufficient goods and Chattels
 to satisfy the sume fo^tld aff^t and the several Officers their fees due to them by action of the
 Premise aff^t as also the fine and fees that accrued against the Said Joseph Holder on any act or Sale
 of his Lordship for an Indulgence for an escape, and the Said Joseph Holder being amiss so of
 Court could not dispose of him to satisfy the sume fo^tld aff^t and fees, aff^t according to law
