Richardson, John Gilleatt, James Caldwell, George Benston who being duly elected tried & sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their oath do say that the said Capote King is not of the premises above supposed upon him &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the seventeenth day of June and do one thousand seven hundred & twenty four that the said Capote King be there of acquitted & goe thereof without day &c. But whereas the said Capote King being bound to the peace at the prayer of the said Alld^g Hall who had sworn the same against him; they being now both present here in Court the said Capote prays the Court that he may be discharged from the same recognizance which by the consent of the said Alld^g Hall, he is by the Court discharged as is agreed &c.
