

There is Consent that then he the said Benjamin Tule shall pay the condemnation of the Court, or under his Body to the custody of the Sherif of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the said Christopher Glast will do it for him &

Whereupon the said Benjamin Tule in his own proper person comes and defends the force and Injury when &c. and says that he cannot gain say the action of the said Henry Sparling and Lewis Denwood so as to say against him brought nor can he say but that the said Henry Sparling and Lewis Denwood ^{sought to} recover their damages by reason of the premises, and to forty one shillings four pence money and Costs of Suite against him which the said Glast does not gain say

Therefore it is considered by the Justice here the sixteenth day of June and Doin. One thousand seven hundred & twenty four that the said Henry Sparling and Lewis Denwood recover against the said Benj. Tule as well the sum of forty one shillings four pence money ^{the} damages as in form aforesaid as also the sum of Two hundred & seventy one pounds of tobacco by the Court here adjudged untaken for himself and Charges by them about their Suite in this behalf said out and expended & of such moneys as

Whereupon the said Stungor Dickson appears and at the prayer of the said attorney is adjudged to give Specials to the action aforesaid but for want thereof the said Stungor Dickson is committed into the custody of the Sherif of Somerset County thence to be taken &c. the said Sherif. Grant here in Court took charge of the said Stungor Dickson accordingly & and at the prayer of the said Stungor Dickson. The said Richard Hickman is adjudged to give Security for costs in case the same be obtained against him the aforesaid &c.

Whereupon Joseph M. Carter of Somerset County Grant Grant in Court in order that for the said Richard Hickman that in case he be thought in & else aforesaid or otherwise legally fall that then he the said Richard Hickman shall pay the condemnation of the Court and all costs answering thereon to the said Stungor Dickson or that he the said Jos. M. Carter will do it for him &c.

Whereas of Sherif of Somerset County had attached in the hands of certain Thomas Walker & Mary Kenney as of the debts and credits of William Kenney &c. the said Thomas Walker & Mary Kenney in their own proper person ^{appear} and with consent of Thomas Howse the said attorney made oath that they had none of the Effects of the said Wm. Kenney in their hands, therefore they are discharged &c.
