appointed Commissioners to Examine Evidence as by the Court aforesaid is praid and that a Com-
mission to them issue &c

Whereas aforesaid Abraham Smith having abused John Manchester one of the
Justices of Somerset County, by calling him a Fool & giving him other Scandalous Language
&c the said Abraham Smith present in Court, is fined by the Justices thereof the
Sum of Sixty pounds of t^l to his Lordship the Lord proprietary for the fact aforesaid

Upon the Petⁿ of the Inhabitants of the sea side for the flooring a Road from the sea
side up the Indian River to the ferry and that aforesaid Jones Prickett be overseer
the petⁿ is granted as praid & that the same Road be floored according to the direction
of Capt J. D. Smith

Whereas the County Standard is now kept at the plantation of Capt John Scott at
Head of Mannum &c It is Ordered by the Court that John Jones and Wm^m Sloughen of
Somerset County Gent^l go & take the said Standard out of the hands and possession of the said
Scott and deliver the same unto aforesaid Henry Ballard of the County aforesaid and that the same
be by him securely kept at his plantation at Mannum aforesaid. Likewise It is Ordered
that J. Curran and J. MacCarter of the County aforesaid Gent^l meet at some convenient &
Regulate the same Standard &c

Ordered by the Court that J. Scott, Hugh Corbin & Wm^m Taylor give bond in ten p^{ts}
Sterling Cash for their appearance at Next November Court to give Evidence on behalf of
J^l Proprietary against Peter D^r Dickerson &c Whereupon the said John
Scott Hugh Corbin & William Taylor are present in Court acknowledged themselves to have and
