sum of one thousand pounds of tobacco &c also all costs accruing upon the writ of attachment
&c and that the said Richard Holland have his Execution thereof against the said Joseph
Brittingham according to act of Assembly &c —

Memorandum the Garnishee in this case with consent of the said attorney voluntarily takes
his Oath that he hath none of the Effects of the said Thomas Brown in his hands &c —

Madam Betty Gale } This Being an action of trespass upon the case &c where in the Shire of
Edw. David Johnson } Somerset County to whom the writ in the same action was directed comes and
under Oath thereof answers in these words following viz. —
