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two before the Worshipful Charles Ballard and his associates then Justices of Our said Court at Dividing Creek and by Consideration of Our said Court Recovered against a certain James Jones of Stegway parish in Somerset County planter or with the sum of five hundred & ten pounds of tobacco for certain damages as also the sum of two hundred & Ninety One pounds of tobacco by the same Court adjudged unto him for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in this Behalf. Said Out and Expended whereof he is Committed as by the Record & process thereof in Our said Court Remains manifestly appears Execution of the Judgment as yet Remains to be done as by the Intimation of the said Robert we have Received and because we were that those things which in Our said Court are Rightly done and acknowledged should be brought to due Execution Command you that by good & Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the said James Jones that he be and appear before the Justices of Our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County at the third Tuesday of August next to show Cause if anything for himself to state or knoweth to say why the said Robert Martin should not have his Execution of the Judgment against him the said James Jones according to the form of the acknowledged Recovery as he ought or to have if to him it shall seem meet and have you show these the Names of those by whom you make the same known and this writ Witness Joseph Gray Gent. Chief Justice of Our said Court 3rd day of June in the Ninth Year of Our Dominion of England 1724. (H. Allen)

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the Eighteenth day of August and Year One thousand seven hundred & twenty four that the said Robert Martin have his Execution against the said James Jones for or with the sum of five hundred & ten pounds of tobacco for certain damages as also the sum of two hundred & Ninety One pounds of tobacco for his Costs of Suit in the Judgment as specified as also the sum of two hundred & sixty pounds of tobacco by the Court here adjudged unto him for his Costs & Damages Sur. (240) levied by Execution of Writ of Execution of the Judgment as &c.
