Three pounds ten shillings and twenty four pounds of tobacco which sum was recovered by the said George Wilson against James Treham on the Nineteenth day of November and did One thousand seven hundred and twenty three in Somerset County Court, the said thirty three pounds ten shillings & twenty four pounds of tobacco to be levied of your Wdys goods or Chattels Land or tenements for the use of the said George Wilson in case the said James Treham should not pay and satisfy unto the said George Wilson the said thirty three pounds ten shillings and twenty four pounds of tobacco as aforesaid recovered against him with & additional costs thereon on the tenth day of November Next.

The above Judgment was enforced before us two of his Lordships Justices for Somerset County the first day of August and did 1724 Witness our hands.

Ordered by the Court that ~~James~~ Eagle King pay unto John Manning and Merrick Ellis the sum of One hundred & twenty pounds of tobacco each for their attendance four days each as Evidence on behalf of the said Eagle King against Alexander Hall they having made oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court that Eagle King pay unto George Brown the sum of Sixty pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance two days as Evidence on behalf of the said Eagle King against Alexander Hall he having made oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court that Alexander Hall pay unto John Townsend the sum of One hundred & twenty pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance as an Evidence four days for the said Alexander Hall at Eagle King he having made oath to the same &c.

Ld. Jos. M^{rs} Carter } Committed was given to the Coroner of Somerset County that he should take John John Bishop J^{nr}. of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his Bail with and him should safe keep so that he might have his Body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August Next Next to answer unto Joseph M^{rs} Carter Esq. of a plea that he tender unto him five hundred pounds of tobacco which to him he owes and lawfully retains &c. and that those of them should not fail &c.

At which said third Tuesday of August to wit the Eighteenth day of the same month and did One thousand seven hundred & twenty four being the day of the return of the said Writ from the Coroner of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed. Ld. Jos. M^{rs} Carter and made to be taken thereunto the Court here enclosed in their words following viz. Longe Augus p^{re} J^{nr}. Curmell Esq.

Whereupon the said John Bishop J^{nr}. being called appears and thereupon the said John Bishop at the prayer of the J^{rs} to attorney and is and judged to give special Bail to the action and thereupon and tain John Hudson present in Court under takes for the said John Bishop that in case the said Joseph M^{rs} Carter shall recover Judgment in the J^{rs} and against the said John Bishop or that the said John Bishop shall be therein convicted that then he the said John Bishop shall pay the condemnation of the Court thereupon or render his Body to the Custody of the Sher^{iff} of Somerset County in Satisfaction
