Whereupon the said Feague Riggini Relinquisheth his Verification afo, and says that of the premises
afo, as by the Information above, is imposed upon her is guilty thereof, and prays that she may
have Liberty to make fine to the said Lord proprietary for the fact afo.

Wherefore it is considered by the Justice here that the said Feague Riggini be fined
to his Lordship the Lord proprietary the Sum of two hundred pounds of tobacco for the fact afo
thereupon the said Feague Riggini is discharge paying the fine afo and the Severall officers their
fees due by Occasion of the premises afo.

Brenning abetard Child about the twenty fifth day of June in 1724 —

Whereupon the said Catherine McDonald in her own proper person appears and prays
Liberty until next Court to answer the premises afo and it is granted her the same day is given unto
Leon Galah's Lordship's attorney (who for his said Lordship in this Behalfe prosecutes) also —

At which said next Court to with the seventeenth day of November 1724. One thousand Seven hundred
and twenty four Come againe as well the said Catherine McDonald in her own proper person as the said
Leon Galah's Lordship's attorney who for his said Lordship in this Behalfe prosecutes — and the said
Catherine McDonald being set to the Bar (Presented Ready) pleads guilty and submits to the Mercy
of the Court and makes Oath that a certain Negro Man (belonging to another King) called first is the beget-
ter of the Child she stands presented for — Wherefore it is considered by the Justice that according
to the Laws of this province (to prevent such Inordinate Populations afo) there accretes due to this
County of Somerset, from the said Catherine McDonald seven years Service, and likewise the Child so
begett to serve till thirty One years of age — Whereupon Catherine McDonald (And the Child so as
afo Inordinately begett) is sold by the Court unto Ephraim Willson of Somerset County Gentl^{man}: that
is the said Catherine McDonald for seven years and the Child afo till thirty One years of age, that is to
say the said Catherine McDonald and Child to serve the said Ephraim Willson his heirs or assigns in
all such Lawfull Service or Employ^{ment} as he shall Employ them in or about the full term of time afo
In Consideration whereof the said Ephraim Willson promitteth to pay to Somerset County the Sum of
three thousand & two hundred pounds of tobacco &c.
