

Submits to the Mercy of the Court, and is willing to make fine to the said Lord proprietary &c.

Wherefore 'tis considered by the Justice here that the said Daniel Davis be fined five hundred pounds of tobacco to the use of the free School. Thereupon the said Daniel Davis is committed into the custody of the Sher. of Somerset County until he should satisfy the fine &c and all the Officers due by occasion of the premises &c. the said Sher. to wit Joseph Maffester Gent: present in Court took charge of the said Daniel Davis accordingly &c.

Thereupon the said Daniel Davis is Ordered by the Court to give Security for his good behavior and appearance at next Court &c. Whereupon the said Daniel Davis present in Court acknowledged himself to owe & stand fully indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honble the Lord proprietary of this province in the sum of ten pounds. Item to be levied on his body goods or chattels, Land, or tenements for the use of his said Lordship.

In case he doth not make his personall appearance before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek & third Tuesday of March next to answer unto his said Lordship concerning all such Matters & things, as shall be then & there objected against him on his said Lordship's behalf and to stand & abide the Judgmt of the Court thereupon & not to depart the same Court without License thereof & in the Meantime to be of good behavior to all his Lordship's Lige people & Especially to John Smith &c.

Likewise aforesaid William Comiter present in Court undertakes for the said Daniel Davis and acknowledged himself to owe & stand fully indebted unto his said Lordship the Lord proprietary his heirs and Successors in the sum of five pounds. Item to be levied on his Body Goods or chattels, Land, or tenements for the use of his said Lordship. In case the said Daniel Davis doe not make his personall appearance before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March next to answer unto his said Lordship concerning all such Matters and things, as shall be then & there objected against him on his said Lordship's behalf and to stand & abide the Judgmt. of the Court thereupon & not to depart the same Court without License thereof and in the Meantime to be of the good behavior to all his Lordship's Lige people and more Especially to the said John Smith &c.
