At which said next Court to witt the Sixteenth day of June ann<sup>d</sup> Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty four Come againe as well the said p<sup>l</sup>ff as the said def<sup>t</sup> by their attorneys a<sup>d</sup> and the said def<sup>t</sup> by her said attorney as before defend<sup>t</sup> the force and Injury when &c. and as to the first and second promises and assumptions in the declaration a<sup>d</sup> above specified saith that she did not assume upon her self in manner & form as the a<sup>d</sup> Nathaniel above against her hath complained and of this puts her self upon the country &c. *J. Allen Def<sup>t</sup>*

Thereupon at the prayer of the p<sup>l</sup>ffs attorney a<sup>d</sup> the action a<sup>d</sup> between the parties a<sup>d</sup> is continued till next Court --- At which said next Court to witt the Eighteenth day of August ann<sup>d</sup> Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty four Come againe as well the said C<sup>l</sup>ff as the said def<sup>t</sup> by their attorneys a<sup>d</sup> and the said p<sup>l</sup>ff by his said a<sup>d</sup> attorney prays a further continuance hereunto until the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the def<sup>t</sup> also ---

At which said next Court to witt the Seventeenth day of November ann<sup>d</sup> Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty four Come againe the said def<sup>t</sup> by his attorney a<sup>d</sup>, and the said p<sup>l</sup>ff altho' solemnly called comes not nor is his writ & declaration a<sup>d</sup> against the same def<sup>t</sup> further prosecuted ---
