Justices of the Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing free the third Tuesday of August ^{next} to answer unto Edmond Hough of a plea of trespass upon the case &c and that there of the should not fail &c. At which said third Tuesday of August to wit the Eighteenth day of the same month and day: One thousand seven hundred twenty four being the day of the return of the said writ Com^o the said Edmond Hough by his attorney and the Sherr of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed did make the Return thereof in these words vizt: Legi Corpus &c J^r. M^o Lester

Whereupon the said John White being called appears and thereupon the said John White at the prayer of the p^lts attorney is adjudged to give special bail to the action, but for want thereof the said John White is committed into the custody of the Sherr of Somerset County there to remain &c the said Sherr being present took charge of the said John White accordingly — thereupon day is given unto the said John White in custody as of unknown Court & the same day is given to the p^lts also And the said Edmond Hough by his attorney is declared against the said John White in the p^lts as followeth vizt: Somerset County ss.
