Ordered by the Court that Mary Gope widows pay unto Temperance Lane, and John Gope the Sum of One hundred fifty pounds of Tob. Each being due unto Each of them for their attendance Each as Evidence five days for the said Mary Gope agt William Copper they having made Oath to the same & —

Ordered by the Court that John Williamson pay unto John Newbold, the Sum of Three hundred and Eighty pounds of Tobacco being due unto him for his attendance Twelve days as Evidence on behalf of the said John Williamson against William Mathews, he having made Oath to the same & —

Ordered by the Court that William Mathews pay unto John Newbold the Sum of Two hundred and forty pounds of Tobacco being due unto him for his attendance and eight days ^{as Evidence} On behalf of the said William Mathews agt John Williamson he having made Oath to the same & —

Ordered by the Court that William Mathews pay unto Thomas Lane & Nathaniel Lane the Sum of One hundred and eighty pounds of Tobacco each being due unto them for their attendance 6 Days Each as Evidence for the said William Mathews, against John Williamson they having made Oath to the same & —
