Mary Hobbs } March Seventeen hundred and twenty four came into Court Lewis Gale Esq of Indutments,
for the County afo and for the Lord proprietary gives the Court here to understand and be
Informed that Mary Hobbs wife of a certain Jay Hobbs Late of Somerset Parish in the County afo
before the nineteenth day of March Seventeen hundred and twenty four with force and Arms &c in and upon
a certain Thomas Gray in the peace of God and Our said Lord proprietary then and there being an assault
made and him did beat wound and evilly treat so that of his Life it was despaired &c and other
harmes to the same Thomas then and there did doe to the great damage of the same Thomas against the
Peace &c whereof the same Lewis for Our said Lord proprietary prays Advise me: &c
Lewis Gale Esq Indut: &c

Whereupon Mary Hobbs in her own proper person appears and being sett to the
Bar is thereupon Instantly demanded how she would acquitt herself of the premises above -
Imposed upon her says that of the premises afo so as afo upon her Imposed she is guilty thereof
and prays that she may be admitted to make fine to the Lord proprietary for the fact afo, and she
is admitted - Wherefore it is considered by the Justice here that the said Mary Hobbs
be fined to the Lord proprietary the Summe of three hundred pounds of tobacco for the fact afo -
to the use of the said Lord proprietary - thereupon the said Mary Hobbs Ordered to give Security
for the paymt. of the fine afo and all fees that arewed upon the Information afo into the
Severall Officers - Whereupon the afo Jay Hobbs her said husband present in Court undertakes
for the said Mary Hobbs to pay the fine afo and all the Officers fees due upon the Information afo &c

Thereupon It's Ordered by the Court that the said Mary Hobbs give Security
for her good behaviour during the pleasure of the Court - Whereupon the afo Jay Hobbs present
as before in Court undertakes for Mary Hobbs his wife in the Sum of ten pounds Sterd. to be levied on
his body goods or Chattells Lands and tenements for the use of the said Lord proprietary In case the
said Mary Hobbs be not of the good behaviour during the pleasure of the Court &c

John Crawford appears ^{here} in Court according to his recognizance & Indutments to be forced by the Hands of Somerset
County Gentles one of his Lordships the Lord proprietare Justice of the Peace for the County afo and prays that
his appearance may be recorded to save him self and Security from the above recognizance & Indutments
In the Sum of Twenty pounds current money for his appearance in this Court &c
Thereupon said John Crawford's appearance is recorded and he Discharged from the
Recognizance above said he first giving Security for the Paymt. of the severall Officers fees
(due)
