In case the said Patrick Burn does not make his personall appearance before the Justice, of his said Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be holden at Dividing Week the third Tuesday of June Next, to answer unto his said Lordship concerning all such Matters and things as shall be then & there objected against him on his said Lordship's behalfs and to stand & abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon & Not to depart the same Court without Licence there of and in the Mean time to be of the good behaviour to all his said Lordship's Squire people and Especially to the said William Clanner &c

William Lane of Somerset County Gentleman Produeth a Commission as Surveyor of Somerset County &c is approved of he taking the Oath of Office appointed by Law, &c thereupon the said William Lane, took the Oath appointed and Subscribed the Oath of abjuration and test &c
