Justices here the Thirteenth day of April Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three that the Said Robert Martin Recover against the Said William Kanes the Sum of Eight hundred and Seventy pounds of tobs his damages in form of Confused as also the sum of Two hundred & Twenty

(229) Pounds of tobs by the Court here adjudged unto him for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suite in this behalf said Out and Expended and the Rest in Money or

R. A. Robert Martin — Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he Should take G. D. George furnace Taylor if he Should be found in his Behavior and him Should Safe Keey so that he might have his Body before the Justices of this Lordships County Court of Somerset held at Doding Creek the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto Robert Martin ofaglee of trespass upon the Case & that there of he Should not fail —

All which Said third Tuesday of March to witt the Eleventh day of the same month Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty two being the day of the return of the Said Writ comes the Said Robert Martin by Francis Allen his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise comes and makes return thereof to the Court here Underst in these words to

Whereupon the Said George furnace being called appears and therupon the Said George furnace at the prayer of Elth attorney agt is adjudged to give Suretey Bail to the action agt. but for want thereof the Said George furnace is committed into the Custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County there to remaine & the Said Sheriff being present here in Court took Charge of the Said George furnace accordingly

Whereupon the Said George furnace in Custody as agt by George Doshell his attorney Compt
Gray. That he may in favour of Liberty he may have alre all in Custody which is granted him.

Whereupon the Said Robert Martin proceeded against the Said George furnace in Custody as agt in the Case aforesaid — Somerset County sh. George furnace late of Allhollows Parish in the County of Somerset Taylor was attacted to answer unto Robert Martin ofaglee of trespass upon the Case & And whereupon the Said Robert Martin by Francis Allen his attorney Complains against that whereas the agt George the thirteenth day of November in the year of Our Lord God One thousand Seven hundred and twenty one at the agt Parish and County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the agt Robert in the sume of twenty four pounds Six Shillings and One half Penny Lawfull money of America and Seven hundred and twenty Seven pounds of tobs as by an ac
