Perogniano's forfeited } Holden came before me and acknowledged her selfe by way of recognizance to be Indicted
to his Lordship and his Successors in the Sum. of ten pounds Curr. money of the Crown &
due to be levied on her lands and tenements goods and Chattels if she fail in Condition -
The Condition of the above Perogniano is such that if the above Margt. Holden make her Corro-
mate appearance before the Justices of County Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday in March
next then and there to give in her Evidence on behalfe of his Lordship against Joseph Holden then the
