Be it remembred that on the twentyfourth day of November
 in the same term came here into Court Alexander Carlyle by Francis Allen his
 attorney and exhibited to the Justices of the Right Honourable the Lord Proctor
 his certain Bill against Charles Ballard Gentl Chif Justice of the County Court of the Right Honourable the Lord Pro-
 tor of the County Court Present in his own Person of a plea of trespass upon the case
 The tenor of which Bill follows in these words to the Justices of the Right Honourable the Lord Proctor Justice of the County
 Court now held for County of Somersett - S. J. Scott County Esq^r. Alexander Carlyle by Francis Allen his attorney com-
 plaines against Charles Ballard Gentl Chif Justice of the County Court of the Right Honourable the Lord Proctor
 present in his own proper person of a plea of trespass upon the case &c for that whereas the said
 Charles the first day of December anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twelve at Illegney Parish in
 the County of Somersett aforesm^t within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said Alexander
 in four thousand two hundred and eight pounds of tobacco and five pounds seven pence half pence Court
 money it being as well for sundry goods wares and Merchandise by the said Alexander to the said Charles at the
 Special Instance and request of the said Charles at the place and Jurisdiction aforesm^t before that time sold and deliv-
 ed as also for sundry sums of money and tobacco by the said Charles for the said Alexander from sundry Persons
 at the place and Jurisdiction aforesm^t had and received as also for credit by the said Alexander at the place Special
 Instance and request of the said Charles at the place and Jurisdiction aforesm^t given to a certain Joseph Austin as also
 for tobacco by the said Alexander for the said Charles at the place Special Instance and request of the said Charles
 and for his use to a certain Adam Heath at the place and Jurisdiction deposited and paid and being so done of
 indebted the said Charles in Consideration whereof afterwards to wit the day and year aforesm^t at the place aforesm^t within the
 Jurisdiction aforesm^t upon his selfe did assume and to the said Alexander then and there did faithfully promise that
 he the said Charles the said four thousand two hundred and eight pounds of tobacco and five pounds and seven pence
 half pence to the said Alexander when he should be afterwards demanded requested he would well and faithfully
 pay and content and altho' the said Charles hath well and truly paid and satisfied to the said Alexander the aforesm^t
 five pounds and seven pence half pence and two thousand four hundred and twenty eight pounds of tobacco free
 of the aforesm^t thousand two hundred and eight pounds of tobacco left to one thousand seven hundred and
 seventy nine and a half pounds of tobacco besides therof the said Charles his promise and assumption aforesm^t inform
 aforesm^t made little regarding but Clothing and fraudulently Intending the said Alexander in that East Castle
 Subtly to deceive and defraud the said One thousand Seven hundred Seventy Nine and a half pounds of tobacco
 to the said Alexander as yet he hath not paid or to him for the same in any wise presented altho' the same to
 do the said Charles on the first day of August anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty One and
 often afterwards in the Parish and County aforesm^t within the Jurisdiction aforesm^t by the said Alexander he was demand-
 ed to be paid but the same unto him to pay or in any wise for the same to content himselfe hath altogether
 refused and still doth refuse and deny wherupon the said Alexander saith he is worse and hath damage
 to the value of three thousand pounds of tobacco and therefore his damages to be £1000. After the payment of which
 And the said Charles Ballard by his attorney ^{John Gale} his attorney comes and defends the force and injury when
 and gives leave to bring all demands until the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the Court
 also - At which said next Court comes to the nineteenth day of March Anno Domini One thousand
