At which said third Tuesday of March to wit the Nineteenth day of the same Month and Year One thousand Seven hundred and twenty two being the day of the return of the said writ Comes the said Benj<sup>o</sup> Coleman by his attorney afo<sup>o</sup> and the Sher<sup>o</sup> of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Side - wise Comes and makes return thereof to the Court here Endorsed Mr of J<sup>o</sup> M<sup>o</sup> Carter Sher<sup>o</sup>

Whereupon the Court adjourns until the next Tuesday of April next being thirtieth day of the same month Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three, on which day and year Comes againe the said Benj<sup>o</sup> Coleman by his attorney afo<sup>o</sup> - and thereupon the said Benj<sup>o</sup> Coleman by his said attorney prayeth that for as much as he has complied with the Law in order to an attachment he may have Judgment against the said Thomas Maddocks for his damages afo<sup>o</sup> by way of attachment according to act of assembly &c. whereupon for that it seems to the Court here that the said Benj<sup>o</sup> Coleman has complied with the Law as alleged -

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the thirtieth day of April Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three that the said Benj<sup>o</sup> Coleman recover against the said Thomas Maddocks as well the sum of four pounds fourteen Shillings Current money of Maryland his damages by occasion of the Complaint afo<sup>o</sup> as all costs and charges by the said Benj<sup>o</sup> Coleman laid out and expounded about his suite by way of attachment against the goods Chattels or Credits of the said Thomas Maddocks according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c
