Proclamation being made in usual form and the Sh^{rs} of Somerset County to wit M^r Boston Gent^l being called to make return of the Oath of the English Jury, to return the same which Jurors are as follow viz^t - Noah M^r: Carter, William Wallon, Sam^l: Dorigson, John Wells, John Shiles, Thomas Mitchell, John Forman, Nathaniel Hasey, Thomas Cullott, Richard Smulson, Am^l: Cross Riggini W^m: Conitor, Thomas Conitor, Richard Hudson, Thomas Robinson, Richard Holland, Isaac Wittingham, Ester Collier, Gideon Selman, Sarcus Maddux Conkamsok. - who being severally called appears and was sworn and charged and sent out to consider &c. who soon after appears and present to the Court and one Verdict against John Conitor being found that the Court should amend form allowing no matter of substance with the same Verdict: thereupon the English Jurors are accordingly discharged and against the said John Conitor so as aforesaid it ordered that venire facias Issue returnable to next Court.
