Wherefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the Said Bridgett Lowler be led to the Publick —  
whipping Post and there be whipt on the Bare Back with ten lashes well laid on until the Blood ap-  
pears and thereupon as to the corporall Punishment after Command is given to the Sheriff of Som. Co. —  
Comly that he do therof Immediate Execution according to the Judgment after tendered by whipping  
the afo' Bridgett Lowler at the Publick whipping Post with ten lashes on her bare back well laid on until the  
blood appear — Afterwards in the same Court the Sheriff returns that he has done the Execution of the Judgment.  
as to the corporall Punishment after he was commanded — And whereas the Said Bridgett Lowler being a servant  
to M<sup>r</sup>. Thomas Darville It is Ordered and adjudged by the Justices that the Said Bridgett Lowler return home to  
her Said Masters Service, and when her now Service ended, the Said Bridgett Lowler to serve her said Master  
three full months for Satisfaction for Loss of time and trouble her said Master was at, at the time of her being  
delivered of her Bastard Child afo' — Whereupon it is further Ordered by the Court that the Said Bridgett Lowler  
do give security for payment of fees Worrapon Thomas Darville her master present here in Court Underlaid for  
to deliver the Said Bridgett Lowler up to the County Court, or the Sheriff of Said County in Order to Recover the said  
Her several Officers fees due by action of the Commissioners paid for her according to Law &c —

His Lordship — Wee of the grand Jury for the Body of Somerset County do present Thomas Langford Bluntor

the Said Writ Comes the Sheriff of Somerset County and makes return Hearer of Court bid. by Informer to the Court  
Whereupon the Said Thomas Langford in his own Person appears and Being set to the Barre is  
instantly demanded how he would acquit himself of the Commission afo' above Imposed upon him, say-  
ing that of the Commission afo' above Imposed upon him he is guilty thereof and Submits to the mercy of the Court  
and is willing to pay his fine for his fault afo' — Wherefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the Said
