Ordered to give her recognizance in the sum of five pounds, and many further appearance at next November Court to be held at Newbury Creek the third Tuesday of November the same month to give Evidence on behalf of the Lord Proprietor against Thomas Ponsonby —

I stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietor of the Province of Maryland his heirs and Successors in the sum of five pounds, and many to be levied on her Body goods or Chattels Land, or tenements for the use of his Said Lordship. In case the Said Captain Gladden does not make her Court all appearance before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Newbury Creek the third Tuesday of November next to give Evidence on behalf of the Lord Proprietor against the Said Thomas Ponsonby and not to depart the same Court without Evidence therof. Then her above Recognizance to be void otherwise —

His Lordship } wee of the grand Jury of Somerset County do present Mary Roberts of the Parish
Mary Roberts } of Allhollows bearing a Bastard in or about the Month of June last Inst —
Informer — M.R. Elliforeman —

Whereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the Said Mary Roberts of Allhollows Parish in the County of Somerset if she should be found in your Person Baldwin the Person should safe keep so that he might have her Body before His Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Newbury Creek the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto his Lordship concerning certain Complaints against her found &c and that thereof she should not fail &c —

At which Said third Tuesday of March to wit the nineteenth day of the same month and Dated One thousand and Seven hundred and twenty three Being the day of the return of the said Writ Comes the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed and makes return thereof Executed —

Whereupon the Said Mary Roberts in her own Person appears and being called to the Barre whereupon it was demanded how she would acquit her self of the Breaches of above Imposed upon her, says that of the Breaches of above Imposed upon her she is guilty thereof and submits to the Mercy of the Court and makes oath that her Master John Ricketts, her Negro Man called Simeon is the Begotter of the Child she now stands Executed for — But because the Justices hereupon will advise and consider of and upon the Breaches of above Imposed upon her by them Concluded day is given unto the Said Mary Roberts until the next Court to hear thereof their Judgment, for that the same Justices here thereof are not as yett &c —

At which Said next Court to wit the eighteenth day of June A.D. 1723
One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three Comes againe the Said Mary Roberts in her own Person and for as much as the Said Mary Roberts Inferred herself to be Begott with Child by another contrary to the Law of this Province, It is Ordered by the Court that the Said Mary Roberts return home with her Master John Ricketts and serve him till next Court next, which Service is adjudged by the Court to be full Satisfaction for the trouble Loss of time and Charge that the Said John Ricketts was att, with the time of the Child bearing &c.

It is also Ordered by the Court that the Said John Ricketts give her recognizance in thirty pounds, and many to return the Said Mary Roberts to March Court next &c — Whereupon the Said John Ricketts Entered
