Thomas by Francis Allen his Attorney Complains that whereas he laid claim the thirtieth day of November last and to D<sup>r</sup> D<sup>r</sup> and Seven hundred and twenty two at the Parish and County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court was directed unto him Thomas in eight hundred twenty seven pounds of tobacco for Serv<sup>r</sup>s, Rent fees and publick dues and for Barans Heretofore to the said Thomas then and there due owing and unpaid as by an account whereof he himselfe demanded may in Court appear and bring to the office of the Clerk of the said Court - In consideration whereof afterward to wit the day and year aforesaid at the said Court in consideration whereof upon his selfe he did assume and to the said Thomas then and there did faithfully promise that he the said James would pay eight hundred and twenty seven pounds of tobacco to the said Thomas when he should be afterwards demanded requested he would well and faithfully pay and content. Now whereas the said James his promise and assygnation aforesaid made little regarding but clothing and fraudulently intendinge the said Thomas in that part secretly and subtletly to deprive and defraud him of eight hundred and twenty seven pounds of tobacco aforesaid to the said Thomas hath not paid or to him for the same in anywise contented altho' he said to do the said James by the said Thomas the first day of December in this year aforesaid and after afterward at the Parish and County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction as he was then unto requested but the said to him to pay or in anywise to content him refused and still doth refuse and deny wherupon the said Thomas saith that he is worse and hath damage to the value of one thousand six hundred fifty and four pounds of tobacco and whereupon he brings suit against
