Thomas by Francis Allen his attorney complains that whereas the said James the thirtieth day of November last did send One thousand Seven hundred and twenty two at the Parish and County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court was directed unto the said Thomas in Eight hundred twenty seven pounds of tobacco for Sundry Sundry fees and Publick dues and for barance thereupon to the said Thomas then and there due owing and unpaid as by an account thereof herewith annexed may in Court appear and being so directed the said James in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid at the Place aforesaid in consideration thereof gave himself did assume and to the said Thomas then and there did faithfully promise that he the said James should Eight hundred and twenty seven pounds of tobacco to the said Thomas when he should be afterwards thereunto requested he would well and faithfully pay and content. Now the said James his promise and assuring and Subtly to deceive and defraud the said Thomas in that Part of Eight hundred and twenty seven pounds of tobacco to the said Thomas hath not paid or to him for the same in anywise contented altho. the said James to do the said James by the said Thomas the first day of December in the year aforesaid and often afterwards at the Parish and County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction aforesaid was thereunto requested but the said James to him to pay or in anywise to content hath refused and still doth refuse and deny whereupon the said Thomas saith that he is worse and hath damage to the value of One thousand Six hundred fifty and four pounds of tobacco and thereupon he brings Suit in
