Whereupon Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should Summons the Said Eric Collins if he should be in his Bailiwick that all Exors & Legats to be and appear before the Justices of this Lordships County Court of Somerset to be holden at Doding Heath the third Tuesday of June then next to answer the Petition aforesaid, and that the Said Eric Collins have at the time and place aforesaid, the Said Mary Coombs & Lawrence Coombs Exors in the Pet. aforesaid mentioned &c. and that they of them should not fail &c.

All which said third Tuesday of June is with the Eighteenth day of the same Month and Year one thousand seven hundred and twenty three, being the day of the return of the said Writ Com. Westm. of Somerset County & Made to be holden at Doding Heath. Summoned by Ser. M^r Carter Sher. —

Whereupon Com. here into Court was the Said Isabella Bryan the Petitioner as the Said Eric Collins with the two Exors aforesaid and the Petition aforesaid being read, and the Court having heard the several allegations as were on behalf of the Said Petitioner as on the part of the Said Eric Collins and for as much as it doth not appear to the Court here that the Said Exors are abused or any way misused &c. and the Said Exors being willing to remain with the Said Eric, therefore the two Exors are Bound unto the Said Eric Collins as follows &c. —

promiseth to Give the Said Lawrence Coombs the Trade of a Cordwainer, and to lead and write well, and to
give him a young man of two years Old at the Expiration of his Service and to find and provide for him
Lawrence Coombs sufficient meat drink washing Lodging and Clothing during his Service aforesaid unto for
him the Said Lawrence Coombs to have and wear &c. — Whereupon it is Ordered by the Court that the
Said Eric Collins give Security in thirty Pounds with one Surety for the Performance of the Covenants aforesaid
And upon the Said Eric Collins and Nathaniel Williams Both Exors here in Court acknowledged themselves
to be and stand Justly Indebted lawfully and lawfully unto the Said Lawrence Coombs in the Sum of thirty
Pounds Curr. money to be paid on their Bodies goods or Chattels Lands or Tenements to the Use of the Said Lawrence
Coombs in Case the Said Eric Collins does not Comply with the Covenants aforesaid &c. —

Service aforesaid unto for the Said Mary Coombs to have and wear — Whereupon it is Ordered by the
Court that the Said Eric Collins give Security in thirty pounds with one Surety for the Performance of the Covenants
