Due Errors of Thomas Dashwood

At which said third Tuesday of June to wit the Eighteenth day of the same Month and Year. the said Edward Hull and
 seven hundred and twenty three being the day of the return of the said Writ came the said Thomas Dashwood by his
 attorney at and the Sher. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed & it is well known and makes
 return thereof to the Court here entered in these words vizt - Copy of Writ of Jus. M. v. T. v. T.

Whereupon the said Edward Hull in his own proper person appeared before the Court and defended
 the force and injury whereof and says that he cannot justify the said writ nor as against him
 brought nor can he say but that the said writ ought to be given him damages by occasion of the execution of
 to the sum of One thousand five hundred thirty eight pound of tobacco and costs of Suite against him which
 said writ does not justify &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the
 Eighteenth day of June Anno Dom. One thousand seven hundred and twenty three that the said Thomas
 Dashwood recover against the said Edward Hull as well the sum of One thousand five hundred thirty eight
 pound of tobacco certain damages as in form of the Writ as also the sum of Two hundred and forty five

24th last pound of tobacco by the Court here adjudged unto him for his costs and charges by him about
 his Suite in this behalf said out and expended with stay of execution till the tenth of November next and do not
 in money &c.

Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take Jonathan Ray-
 mond of Stepney Parish in Somerset County Glanor if he should be found in his Bailwick
 and him should safe keep so that he might have his Body before the Justices of his
 Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June then next
 to answer unto Henry Lodovic of the said County Glanor of trespass upon the Case &c. and that
 thereof he should not fail &c. And the said Henry Lodovic by George Dashwood his attorney proceeded
