Therefore it is considered by the Justices how the Eighteenth day of June Anno Domini: One thousand seven hundred and twenty three affd that the Said Betty Hale recover against the Said Nathaniel Marsey as were the sum of Three pounds Eighteen Shillings and One penny certain damages affd in form of Confessd as also the sum of two hundred and Seventy two pounds of tobacco by the Court here adjudged to be paid for his costs charges by her about her Suite in this Bkfstg. Laid Out and Expended and the defendant in meny C^o —

John Dashiell } Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Robert Citt of the County of Somerset County and Commonwealth of England alias datus Robert Citt of the County of Sandf^{le} Robert Citt and Province of Maryland Cooper if he ^{should} be found in said Maryland and him should safe keep so that he might have his Body before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court to be held at Bridg^e next the third Tuesday of June then next to answere unto Thomas Dashiell of after affording ^{of Sommerset} the cause that he tender unto him the full and just sum of One thousand four hundred and forty six pounds of tobacco which he had his own and from him unjustly detained & held that whereof he should not sue C^o —

And whereupon the Said Thomas George Dashiell his attorney complaint that whereas the Said Robert Citt the twenty second day of February Anno Domini: One thousand seven hundred and twenty at the place ^{where} he dwelt within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the Said Thomas the sum of One thousand four hundred and forty six pounds tobacco as per his certain Writing Obligatory which the Said Thomas with the Seal of the Said Robert herein before datus Brue dated the day and year affd acknowledged himself to be Indebted as per New Brue the Said Robert the sum of One thousand four hundred and forty six pounds affd as aforesaid according to the tenour of his Said Writing unto the Said Thomas he hath not tendered but the same to tender he hath denied and still doth deny to the damage of the Said Thomas of two thousand eight hundred and thirty two pounds of tobacco and thereupon the Brue's Suite — Dashiell vs Citt C^o J^d Doe R^l D^r Roe —

All which Said third Tuesday of June to wit the Eighteenth day of the same month Attended. One thousand seven hundred and twenty three being the day of the return of the Said Writing to the Said Thomas Dashiell by his attorney affd the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing Writing was directed Likewise for and makes Return thereto to the Court here endorseth. Non est Inventus f^r Joh: Mc Taylor Not^r —

Whereupon the Said Thomas Dashiell by his attorney affd says that forasmuch as he has Complied with ~~the~~ ^{the} Lawes alledged in Order to an attachment he may never Judg^t against the Said Robert Citt for his debt affd by way of attachment according to act of Assembly he Wherupon for that it seems to the Court here that the Said Thomas Dashiell has Complied with the Lawes alledged; — Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the Eighteenth day of June Anno Domini: One thousand seven hundred and twenty three affd that the Said Robert Citt Thomas Dashiell recover against the Said Robert Citt as were the sum of One thousand four hundred and forty six pounds of tobacco his debt affd as all Costs and Damages by the Said Citt Laid Out and Expended about his Suite by way of attachment against his goods chattels or credits of the Said Robert Citt according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided g^o —
