and Nineteen twenty at the Parish afo<sup>t</sup> within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain Bill whiche the  
Said Thomas and Mary with the Seal of the Said Robert Signed hereto to Court Bringis whose date is  
the day and year afo<sup>t</sup> bound himself to pay unto the afo<sup>t</sup> John Griffill in his Lifetime his Es<sup>t</sup> ad*m* &  
the afo<sup>t</sup> sum of fifteen hundred pounds of tobacco upon the first day of December next ensuing the date  
of the writing afo<sup>t</sup> Never to let the afo<sup>t</sup> Robert altho' often desired the afo<sup>t</sup> sum of fifteen-  
hundred pounds of tobacco or any Part thereof to the said John in his Lifetime or to the afo<sup>t</sup> May after  
the death of the afo<sup>t</sup> John Before Esposalls Between him and the afo<sup>t</sup> Thomas celebrated or to the afo<sup>t</sup>  
Thomas and Mary Since Esposalls Between them Celebrated hath not rendered but the said or any  
Part thereof to them billable to render hath delayed and shall do the day to the damage of the Said Thomas  
and Mary five hundred pounds of tobacco and the cost of the Bring his Suite &

the foregoing writ was directed Likewise comes and makes return thereof to the Court law Cusht in

Assembly &c. Whereupon for that it seems to the Court here that the said Thomas Drummond and Mary his  
wife ad*m* as afo<sup>t</sup> hath Comply with the Law as alledged; —

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices  
the Eighteenth day of June Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty three afo<sup>t</sup> that the said  
Thomas Drummond and Mary his wife ad*m* afo<sup>t</sup> recover against the Said Robert Gitts as well the sum  
of fifteen hundred pounds of tobacco their debt afo<sup>t</sup> as all Costs and Damages by the said Esq<sup>r</sup> Jas. M. Carter  
Expended about their Suit by way of attachment against the good, Chattels and Credit of the Said Robert  
Gitts according to act of Assembly in such Case made and Provided &
