Now it is shown that the said Robert Corry has complied with the Law as alleged; - Therefore it is Considered by the Justice here the Eighteenth day of June And Done: One thousand seven hundred and twenty three that the said Thomas Dashield Recover against the said Robert Corry as well the sum of Six hundred and Sixty pounds of tobacco his damages by Breach of the promise aforesaid as all costs and Charges by the said Corry paid and Expended about his Suite by way of attachment against the goods (shells and Credits) of the said Robert Corry according to act of assembly in such case made and provided
