pounds of curr. money of Maryland and thereupon he bringeth his suit <sup>cō</sup>.

At which said third Tuesday of June to witt the eighth day of the same month and year: One thousand  
seven hundred and twenty three being the day of the return of the said writt comers the said Robert  
Martin by his attorney and the attorney of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was directed  
likewise comes witness whereof to the court and Exonst. his C. for the sum of one thousand  
pounds of curr. money of Maryland and thereupon he bringeth his suit <sup>cō</sup>.

Whereupon the said Charles Ramsey and Abraham Lamberson with their own Prorogue  
persons come and defend the said and injury wherein <sup>cō</sup>. And say that they cannot gainsay the said Eliz  
action oft so as oft against him brought nor can they say but that the said Eliz ought to recover his damages  
by occasion of the damages oft to the sum of twenty two shillings Silver currency and one hundred  
and seventy two pounds of tobacco, and costs of suit against them which the said Eliz does not gainsay <sup>cō</sup>.

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the eighteenth day of June anno  
Dom: One thousand seven hundred and twenty three oft that the said Robert Martin recover against the  
said Charles Ramsey and Abraham Lamberson as well the sum of twenty two shillings Silver currency of  
Maryland and One hundred Seventy two pounds of tobacco certain damages oft in sum oft one hundred  
~~and~~ <sup>300</sup> the sum of Three hundred and Nine - <sup>cō</sup> pounds of tobacco by the court  
one adjudged unto him for his costs and charges by <sup>aboutly</sup> <sup>his</sup> <sup>in this behalf</sup> Laid Out and Expended and  
it doth in money <sup>cō</sup>.

And whereupon the said Robert Martin by Francis Allen his attorney complains that whereas  
he said Robert Gitt the ninth day of November Anno Dom: One thousand seven hundred and twenty two  
at <sup>of Indigo</sup> Citt and County oft within the jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said Robert Martin  
in sum of One hundred and Ninety three pounds of tobacco for divers Item fees and Lubluk dues  
and for beuance whereupon to the said Robert Martin then and thereto owing and unpaid by an account  
of his unto another may appear and being so thereof indebted the said Robert Gitt in consideration  
whereof afterwards to wit the day and year oft at the place oft in consideration whereof upon himself  
did affirme and to the said Robert Martin then and thereto failing did promise that he the said Robert  
Gitt he oft One thousand One hundred and Ninety three pounds of tobacco to the said Robert  
Martin whom he should be afterwards required to request he would well and faithfully pay and  
fulfill <sup>the</sup> (but not)
