Whereupon the Said Charles Ramsey and Abraham Lamberson in their own proper  
persons Comor and defend the fore and Injury when &c. And say that they cannot gain say the Effe<sup>cts</sup>  
action &c to as &c against him brought nor can they say but that the Said Effe<sup>cts</sup> ought to recover his dam-  
ages by Occasion of the Comores &c to the Sum of twenty two Shillings Silver Currency and One hundred  
and Seventy <sup>two</sup> pounds of tob<sup>acco</sup>, and Costs of Suite against them which the Said Effe<sup>cts</sup> does not gain say &c.

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the Eighteenth day of June And  
Dowd: One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three &c that the Said Robert Naine recover against the  
Said Charles Ramsey and Abraham Lamberson as well the Sum of twenty two Shillings Silver Currency of  
Maryland and One hundred Seventy <sup>two</sup> pounds of tob<sup>acco</sup>. Certain damages &c in full &c referred as also  
(300) the Sum of Three hundred and Nine <sup>Shillings</sup> <sup>of tob<sup>acco</sup></sup> by the Court  
and adjudged unto him for his Costs and Charges by him <sup>about his Suit</sup> in this Writ half Paid Out and Expended and  
Def<sup>er</sup>ts in money &c

his Inds. h<sup>is</sup> County Court, to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June then next to answer  
unto Robert Martin of ag<sup>t</sup> of trespass upon the Case &c. and that he should not fail &c

And whereupon the Said Robert Martin by Francis Allen his attorney Complain that whereas  
the Said Robert Citti the thirteenth day of November And Dowd: One thousand Seven hundred and twenty two  
at & Carish and County &c within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the Said Robert Martin  
in sum the sum and One hundred and Ninety three pounds of tob<sup>acco</sup> for Lewis Sher. fees and Culluck Dues  
and for betwixt thereupon to the Said Robert Martin then and thereupon owing and unpaid by an act  
that of his unto answer may appear and being so there of indebted the Said Robert Citti in Consideration  
thereof afterwards to witt 5 Day and Year &c at the Place &c in Consideration thereof upon himself  
did assume and to the Said Robert Martin then and there faithfully did promise that to the Said Robert  
Citti he &c One thousand One hundred and Ninety three pounds of tob<sup>acco</sup> to the Said Robert  
Martin when he should be afterwards thereunto requested he would well and faithfully pay and  
(Robert)
