Jos. H<sup>t</sup> & C<sup>r</sup>ist<sup>r</sup> New<sup>r</sup>. Whereas on the Said Robert Martin by his attorney aff<sup>r</sup>ays that forasmuch  
as he has Complained with the Law in Order to an attachment he may have Judgm<sup>t</sup> for the same against the  
goods and Chattels lights or credits of the Said Robert Citt according to act of assembly for.

Whereupon for that it seems to the Court that the Said Robert Martin has Complained  
with the Laws as alledged,

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the Eighteenth

day of June Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three aff<sup>r</sup> that the Said Robert —  
Martin Person against the Said Robert Citt as wote the sum of One thousand Seven hundred  
and forty three pounds after his damages by reason of the Grievance aff<sup>r</sup> as all costs and charges by the  
Said C<sup>r</sup>it laid out and Expended about his suit by way of attachment against his goods, Chattel Rights  
or Credits of the Said Robert Citt according to act of assembly in such case made and provided

Sayag<sup>t</sup> John M<sup>c</sup> Carter } On the 11<sup>th</sup> was given to the Clerk of Somerset County that he Should take Thomas  
D<sup>r</sup> Johnson — Johnson of Plantisore hundred in the County of Somerset Clerk if he Should be found  
in his Balswick and his should safe keep so that he might have his Body before the Justices of this  
Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June next to answer  
unto Capt<sup>r</sup> John M<sup>c</sup> Carter of ye old of Longfane upon the Case &c<sup>r</sup> and that he should not fail &c<sup>r</sup> —

And whereupon the Same John by Francis Allen his attorney Complaineth that whereas the aff<sup>r</sup> Thomas  
the second day of May in the year of Our Lord God One thousand Seven hundred and twenty One at Somerset County  
and within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the aff<sup>r</sup> John in the sum of Nine hundred and  
fifty pounds of tobacco for so much by the Same John for the aff<sup>r</sup> Thomas at the Expire of instance and layest  
of the aff<sup>r</sup> Thomas before that time to a certain Tobac<sup>r</sup> Board deposited and laid as by a certain Note here  
in Court ready to be produced may appear and consider of being Indebted the aff<sup>r</sup> Thomas afterwards to wit the  
same twenty second day of May in the year of Our Lord God One thousand Seven hundred and twenty One  
thereof upon his selfe did aff<sup>r</sup> unto the aff<sup>r</sup> John then and there faithfully did promise that he d<sup>r</sup>  
aff<sup>r</sup> Thomas the summe Nine hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco unto the same John whereupon afterwards,  
he should be required well and faithfully would pay and content himselfe the aff<sup>r</sup> Thomas his promise and  
assumption aff<sup>r</sup> so as it is said made nothing regarding but minding and fraudulently intending the same  
John in this Part (casually and Subtly) to defraude and defraud the aff<sup>r</sup> Nine hundred and fifty pounds of  
tobacco or any Part thereof unto the same John hath not paid or in any sort contented altho' to do the same  
the aff<sup>r</sup> Thomas afterwards to wit the thirteenth day of May in the year of Our Lord God Seventeen hundred  
and twenty One aff<sup>r</sup> at County aff<sup>r</sup> within the Jurisdiction aff<sup>r</sup> by the aff<sup>r</sup> John he was Required but that he  
him selfe to pay or in any sort to content allegation hath refused and still doth refuse to do damage  
of the Said John of Eighteen hundred pounds of tobacco and whereupon he brought this suit &
