Horsey Esq^r and John Gunby and Sarah his wife Esq^r & others the Said Esq^r Recovered Judgment against the said debts

as well for the sum of Eleven pounds fourteen shillings six pence half pence a certain debt due and recovered —

whereof they are bound as also the sum of two hundred and twenty four pounds aforesaid costs of suit and for that

Execution hath not therupon I issued wee therefore command you that by good and Lawfull men of your Balswick

you make known unto the said John Gunby and Sarah his wife Esq^r that they be and appear before the Justices of

Our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March instant to Show cause if any they lawfully

the said person Judgment afo^t for the debt and costs afo^t according to the form of the Recovery afo^t against them the said

John Gunby and Sarah his wife Esq^r ought not to have if to have it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this —
