

Prays that upon giving Security according to Law that the Said Sum of Five pounds and Nine pence as of the Rights and Credits of the Said William Martindale Earl of the Sum attached and Confessed may be Condemned in the hands of the Said Richard Hudson garnishe as aforesaid towards Satisfying of the Said Charles Ratcliff damages and Costs aforesaid.

Thereupon a certain William Wallon of Sommersett County Esquire present here in Court undertakes for the Said Charles Ratcliff Esquire as of according to act of assembly that if in case the Said William Martindale do at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the Said Charles Ratcliff Esq. aforesaid claims against him to be satisfied or otherwise to have been undue before the daying of this attachment that then the Said Charles Ratcliff Esq. aforesaid shall make Restitution unto him the Said William Martindale of all or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue &c or that he the Said William Wallon will do it for him &c

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the Eighteenth day of June
in the Year Dated One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three that the Said Sum of Five pounds and Nine pence part of the Sum so attached, and Confessed, be Condemned in the hands of the Said Richard Hudson as of the Rights and Credits of the Said William Martindale towards Satisfying of the Said Charles Ratcliff Esq. aforesaid as well his damages aforesaid as also the Costs accruing upon the Writ of attachment aforesaid and that the Said Charles Ratcliff Esq. aforesaid have his Execution there of against the said Richard Hudson according to act of assembly
mentioning the garnishee Richard Hudson
Voluntarily takes his Oath that he hath no more of the Effects of the Said debts in his hands than
what he has Confessed &c
