But that he and his Cledges of presenting the writ is John Doe and Richard Roe be in money afo and the afo Thomas Drummond and Mary his wife Countrie of the afo John Griffin go thereof with out day afo — And further it is considered that the said Thomas Drummond and Mary his wife Countrie as afo recover against the said Edmund Stough the sum of Two hundred & Twenty Six pounds of tobacco by the Court here adjudged in tolling for their costs and Charges by them about their said defence afo in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute in such Cases lately made and provided and that the same dopts have these of their Exrs afo —
