of Somerset County greeting We Command you that you attack any the goods Cattle Lights or Credits of Jonathan Thunstone late of Somerset County if they shall be found in your Bailewick to the Value of two pounds ten Shillings and three hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attacked or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before the Justices of Our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June next there and there to be condemned according to act of Assembly to and for the use of certain Nehemiah Merick unless the said Jonathan Thunstone by himself or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Nehemiah Merick in person of his goods upon the case & according to Law and that by good and sufficient men of your Bailewick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of Our Said Court to be held as aforesaid to show cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Cattle Lights or Credits in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereon had and made according to the form of the act of Assembly in that case made and provided if it turn her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this writt that you make known unto Our Said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you there and there this writt witness Charles Ballard yeah Chief Justice of Our Said Court the 23 day of March in the eighth year of Our Dominion 1722 - (G. daschick) Thomas Hayward (D)

At which said third Tuesday of June to the eighteenth day of the same month and Year One thousand seven hundred and twenty three being the day of the return of the said writt comes the said Nehemiah Merick by his attorney aforesaid and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed hereinbefore comes and makes return thereof to the court here endorset in these words viz.

By virtue of the Writt aforesaid directed to the Justices herein mentioned I have attacked in the hands of Richard Wallace and sumonred him as garnishee, the goods and Cattle of the within named son of Thunstone three hundred and seventy two pounds of tobacco one pound and thirty six bushells and one peck of salt and nine bushells of coal and coke 26 and I have made known unto the said Richard Wallace that he be appear before the Justices within mentioned at the day and place within return'd to show cause if any he have why the said several sums of money and tobacco so attacked in his hands as the goods and Cattle of the aforesaid Jonathan Thunstone should not be condemned and Execution thereon made before the day and time the said goods and Law-suit men affyng Bailewick as by the Writt to me I am commanded to answer for Mr Peter Sher

Whereupon the said Richard Wallace altho' solemnly called comes not nor does cause why & but makes default whereby the said Court remains hereof wholly undefended &

Whereupon the said Nehemiah Merick by his attorney aforesaid prays that the several goods and tobacco aforesaid of the value of five pounds eight shillings as of the lights and Credits of the said Jonathan Thunstone may be condemned in the hands of the said Richard Wallace towards satisfying unto the said Nehemiah Merick as well the sum of two pounds ten shillings and three hundred pounds of tobacco as also the costs amounting upon the writ of attachment aforesaid

Therefore it is considered by the Justices for the eighteenth day of June and Year One thousand seven hundred and twenty three that the said sum of three hundred and seventy two pounds of tobacco of the value of two pounds thirteen shillings; thirty six bushells; one peck of salt of the value of three pounds twelve shillings and six pence and one peck coke of the value of two shillings and six pence as aforesaid attacked be condemned in the hands of the said Richard Wallace as of the lights and Credits of the said Jonathan Thunstone towards
