Sherrif of Somerset County greeting We Command you that you attach any the goods Chattels rights or credits of Thomas Drummond and Mary his wife if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of fifteen hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same so attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before the Justices of Our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County sh<sup>r</sup>. the third Tuesday of June next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to Satisfie into a certain John Dennis J<sup>d</sup>. the Sum of One thousand One hundred and fifty two pounds of tobacco which to the said John Dennis was adjudged for his costs and Charges by him about his defence in a certain action of Tres pass upon the Case by the said Thomas Drummond and Mary his wife against the said John Dennis in Our said Court before the Justices thereof on the thirteenth day of Aprill last past lately Brought Sustained according to the form of the Statute thereupon lately made and provided whereof the said Thomas Drummond & Mary his wife are Comitt as appears upon records and also all costs and Charges upon this Our Writ of attachment and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the persons or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of Our said Court to be held as aforesaid to show Cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels rights or credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof and made according to the form of the act of assembly in that Case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this Writ that you make known unto Our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this Writ Witness Charles Ballard Gent Chief Justice of Our said Court the 3<sup>d</sup> day of May in the Eighth year of Our Dominion &c Anno Domini 1723 - J<sup>r</sup>.
