At which said third Tuesday of June to wit the Eighteenth day of the same month Aforesaid One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three being the day of the return of the said Writ Cometh the said John Scarbrough by his attorney aforesaid and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing Writ was directed Likewise Cometh and makes return thereof to the Court here Enrolled in these words following viz

By virtue of the Within Writ to me directed I have attached in the hands of the several persons in schedule to this writ annexed as the goods and Chattels of the Within named William Gilchrist I have made known unto the several persons that they be and appear before the Justices Within mentioned at the day and place within contained to show Cause if any they have why the said several Sums of Money so attached in the hands of as the goods and Chattels of the aforesaid William Gilchrist should not be condemned and Execution thereof made before John Doe and Richard Roe good and lawfull men of my Bidwick as by the Within Writ I am commanded so answereth for: Me Charles Sten

- In the hands of Somfett Dickenson --- 12.6
- In the hands of Charles Ramsay --- 1. 3. 1x

Whereupon the said Daniel Cordery garnishes ^{as aforesaid} within his own proper person appears and voluntarily with Consent of the aforesaid attorney takes his Oath that he hath none of the Rights and Credits of the said Defts in his hands thereupon the said Daniel Cordery is discharged

Likewise the aforesaid Somfett Dickenson ^{garnishes as aforesaid} altho' solemnly called Cometh not nor shows Cause why he should make default whereby the said aforesaid Ramsay thereof wholly indefined &c

Whereupon the said Charles Ramsay garnishes of the aforesaid William Gilchrist appears in his own proper person and says that he cannot garnish but that he has of the Rights and Credits of the said William Gilchrist to the value of Nine Shillings and two pence nor but that the same ought to be condemned in his hands for the use of the said John Scarbrough as of the Rights and Credits of the said William Gilchrist which the said aforesaid does not garnish

Whereupon the said John Scarbrough by his attorney aforesaid ^{grays} that the Sums aforesaid ^{is} Confessed by the said ~~Somfett~~ Charles Ramsay and attached in the hands of the said Somersett Dickenson as of the Rights and Credits of the said William Gilchrist may be condemned in the hands of the said Charles Ramsay & Somfett (Dickenson)
