I Certifie that I have given Notice unto the within named Thomas Goddard that he be and appear at the time
and place within contained before the Justices within Mentioned to shew cause if any he hath or knoweth to say
why the within named Thomas Collier and Ann his wife admt. as within Mentioned should not have their Execution
against him for the Debt and Cost within contained before Hugh Collier and John Doe good and lawfull men of
my Bailiwick as by the within Writt of me commanded to answer of Jas: Webster Sheriff —

Whereupon the said Thomas Collier and Ann his wife admt. as afft by George Dashell their
attorney afft pray that the said Thomas Goddard to their will of their fauor afft may Answer But the
said Thomas Goddard altho' solemnly called comes not but makes default whereby the said Justices remain
against the said debt wholly undespised &c —

There fore it is Considered by the Justices here the
Eighteenth day of June Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and twenty three that the said Thomas Collier
Ann his wife admt. as afft have their Execution against the said Thomas Goddard for a summe of Sixteen
Thousand pounds of tobacco their debt afft as also the summe of Three hundred and fifty Pounds of old Cots of
Sute in the Judgment afft specified as also the summe of Three hundred and Twenty Nine
⁽⁹²⁹⁾ pounds of tobacco by the Court here adjudged unto him for his Costs and Damages sustained by reason of Delay of
Execution of the Judgment afft &c —
