Whereupon the said Thomas Collier and Ann his wife admt. as aft by George Dashiell their
attorney aft. pray that the said Thomas Goddard to their writt of their facias aft may Answer But the
said Thomas Goddard altho solemnly called comes not but makes default whereby the said writt remains
against the said defth wholly undefeided &c

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the
Eighteenth day of June Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and twenty three that the said Thomas Collier &
Ann his wife admt. as aft have their Execution against the said Thomas Goddard for as well the sume of Sixteen
thousand pounds of tobacco their debt aft as also the sum of three hundred and fifty One pound of tobacco Costs of
Suite in the Judgmt. aft specified as also the sum of Three hundred Twenty nine
pounds of tobacco by the Court here adjudged unto him for his Costs and Damages Sustained by Reason of Delay of
Execution of the Judgmt. aft &c
